

Dems Will Study Reapportionment, School Proposals

A former vice president of the Michigan Constitutional Convention will analyze current efforts for reapportionment at the next meeting of the Birmingham Democratic Club.

The meeting is scheduled for 8 p.m. Tuesday at The Community House.

The speaker will be Tom Downs, who will discuss both legislative and congressional reapportionment. He has followed the apportionment situation closely as legislative representative of the Michigan DAW-CIO.

He is also expected to point out other areas in which legislation has been suggested to implement or modify the new constitution.
