At the meeting were: J. Ted Eschele, Donald C. Nolte, Maurice A. Betman, Harold E. McGill and John W. Faigle.

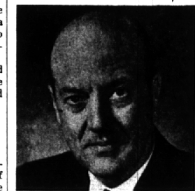
Award Winner
