CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE, granting to CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right and authority to lay, maintain and operate gas mains, pipes and services on, along, across and under the streets, alleys and other public places, and to do a local gas business in the CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, for a period of twenty years.

THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS ORDAINS:

Section 1. That whenever the word "Grantee" appears in this ordinance, it is intended to designate, and shall be held to refer to the Consumers Power Company, its successors and assigns.

Section 2. The right and authority is hereby granted to said Grantee, its successors and assigns, to lay, maintain and operate gas mains, pipes and services on, along, across and under the streets, alleys and other public places, and to do a local gas business in the City of Bloomfield Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, for a period of twenty years.

Section 3. No street, alley or public place used by said Grantee shall be obstructed longer than necessary during the work of construction and maintenance, and shall be restored to the same good order and condition as when such work was commenced.

Section 4. All pipes and mains shall be laid and maintained in a careful and proper manner so as not to injure persons and property; the Grantee shall be liable for any damage to persons or property caused by its failure so to do.

Section 5. The Grantee shall be entitled to charge said City and its inhabitants for gas furnished therein, the rates which have been approved by the Michigan Public Service Commission or its statutory successor, to which Commission the authority and jurisdiction to fix, regulate and alter gas rates and rules regulating such service in said City, are hereby granted for the term of this franchise. Such rates and rules shall be subject to review and change at any time upon petition therefor being made by either the City, acting by its City Commission, or by said Grantee.

All bills for gas service shall be payable monthly. The Grantee may collect the minimum charge as specified in its rate schedules. It shall also furnish and maintain commercially accurate meters to measure the gas furnished. Said Grantee shall at all reasonable times have access to the premises of its customers for the purpose of reading, inspecting, removing and replacing such meters.

Section 6. The Grantee shall provide gas service within said City, and shall extend its gas distribution system whenever the amount of gas to be furnished thereby shall provide an adequate and reasonable return upon the cost of providing such service.

The said Grantee shall, before entering upon any street, highway, alley or other public place for the purpose of constructing or installing any mains, pipes, gas works or other apparatus, notify the City Manager in writing of the proposed construction or installation and obtain a permit therefor, and shall, if the City Manager so requires, file with the City of Bloomfield Hills, a sufficient plan and specification, showing the nature and extent of the proposed construction or installation to the City of Bloomfield Hills, a map showing distribution of its gas mains at the time of the effect of this franchise and be prepared to revise said map once yearly as soon after January 1 of each year as possible during the period of this franchise.

Section 7. The rights, power and authority herein granted are not exclusive. This franchise shall not be leased, assigned or otherwise alienated except to a corporation which shall be the lessee, assignee or grantee of all of the gas properties of said Grantee within the City of Bloomfield Hills.

Section 8. The City reserves the right to make all regulations which shall be necessary to secure the safety in the most ample manner, welfare and accommodation of the public, including, among other things, the right to pass and enforce ordinances to require proper and adequate extensions of the service of such grant in the manner heretofore provided, and to protect the public from danger or inconvenience in the operation of any work or business authorized by the grant hereof and the right to make and enforce all such regulations as shall be reasonably necessary to secure adequate, sufficient and proper service, extensions and accommodations for the people, and insure their comfort and convenience.

Compliance by said Grantee with the duties and obligations hereby assumed by and imposed upon it, shall be deemed to constitute fair compensation for the rights hereby granted. Said Grantee shall, as to all other conditions and elements of service not herein fixed, be and remain subject to the reasonable rules and regulations of the Michigan Public Service Commission or its successors, applicable to gas service within said City.

Section 9. In order to become binding, this ordinance shall be accepted in writing by said Grantee within thirty days from the date of its enactment, which acceptance shall be filed with the City Clerk. The grant hereof shall be subject to ratification by the affirmative vote of at least three-fifths of the electors of said City voting thereon at a regular or special municipal election to be held in the manner provided by law. This ordinance shall become effective upon the date of its publication as provided in the City Charter and, if ratified by the electors, shall remain in effect for a period of twenty years from and after its effective date.

Made and passed by the Commission of the City of Bloomfield Hills at a regular meeting held May 12, 1964.
