GOP Divides 3rd District

In a continuing effort to increase the Oakland County Republican Party's organizational strength, Charles L. Lyle, GOP county chairman, has announced that the Third Legislative District will be divided into two districts, each under its own district director.

One district will contain the townships of West Bloomfield, Commerce, and Milford, and the cities of Walled Lake and Keego Harbor. The other district will contain the areas of Bloomfield and Avon Townships, and the cities of Bloomfield Hills, Birmingham and Troy.

Lyle indicated that this proposal has been under consideration for some time in that the geographical area of the Third Legislative District makes it impractical for one individual to give it the attention it deserves. Lyle will make the necessary appointments of the new directors in the near future.
