# Science Instructor Off to India for Summer Assignment

Manert H. Kennedy, science teacher at Fraser High School and son of the Joseph Kennedys of Hylane Drive, flew to Bombay, India last weekend to teach for the summer. He will help shape the biological science curriculum for the students in far-off India.

During the summer program which will begin June 6, he will meet with eight other American biologists and eight Indian scientists to staff science institutes for India's high school teachers at four universities. Kennedy will be biology curriculum consultant. He will travel through India during and after the program affording him the opportunity of observing the local techniques and culture.

The Fraser science teacher has also scheduled brief visits to Paris, Berlin, Rome, the Holy Land and the Orient before his trip home in August. His final stop will be Boulder, Colo. to report to the central staff, headquarters of the study. Looking forward to his return will be his wife and the seven little Kennedys.
