The World Bridge Olympiad of 1964 found the United States coming in second. They were second in the men's section to Italy and second to England for the ladies, so we were at least consistent.

The hand I have selected for today was played in this tournament when Italy played against the English men's team. The purpose of showing this hand is not to run down the Italian team, as that would be impossible, but to show that the world Olympiad Team can make the same mistakes that you and I do.

West hoped to find a singleton club queen, that was the reason for this lead. Belladonna made

the proper lead of the 10 of hearts from dummy on the second play and allowed West to take this trick with the queen.

West returned a second club which was won in the closed hand. Now all the declarer had to do was to enter the dummy with the ace of spades and take the second hook in hearts and collect nine tricks. However, he now laid down the ace of hearts and collected a total of eight tricks, for down one.

WHEN OUR TEAM from the United States played this hand, Robert Jordan was the declarer at four hearts and was able to make the contract. He end-played west in the diamond suit, forcing West to lead a club.

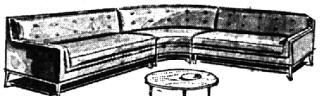
