BEHIND the STORE FRONTS

In the multitude of things to do and see during the centennial celebration you may have missed the window display at Wilson's Drugs (Woodward-Maple store) and the Prep Shop (Pierce St.) window.

In the pharmacy window, Richard Adams spent a good deal of time in details of past days, showing old time apothecary equipment when potions were hand ground and carefully weighed.

A National Hotel registry book is displayed (which the hotel clerk probably grabbed when he fled the fire that destroyed the hotel (formerly on the site of the Hamilton branch of the Detroit Bank and Trust).

Also displayed are old prescriptions dating back to 1908 and earlier. Old time pictures in the window are from Manley Bailey's collection.

The Wilson Drug Co. was founded in 1923, when Ralph A. Wilson bought the business from Cobb & Cobb. The firm continues under the leadership of Richard J. Wilson, President. The display will remain up for a time.

Hills Man Reaches Top in Food Chain

The recent announcement by James L. Honigman, chairman of the board of Allied Supermarkets, Inc., of the election of I. R. Moore, to the presidency of the Detroit-based 237 store national supermarket chain, highlights the career of this 52-year-old food industry executive.

Moore, 1684 Keller Lane, Bloomfield Hills, started in the food business in 1934 as a stock clerk for the Standard Humpty Dumpty stores in Oklahoma City.

His instincts as a merchant and an administrator were soon apparent and he progressed through various store management and supervisory positions until he became sales manager of the Humpty Dumpty organization in 1952.

In 1955, when the Humpty Dumpty stores were merged with those of the Wrigley and Big Bear Supermarkets and the Abner A. Wolf Wholesale Grocery Co., all of Detroit, to form ACF-Wrigley, Moore was named a vice president and director of sales of the new company's Oklahoma Division.

He was appointed that division's general manager in 1958, a position he held for one year when he moved to Detroit to serve in a similar capacity for the company's largest division.

In 1961 he was named executive vice president and a member of the board of directors of the company, by now known as Allied Supermarkets, Inc., and has held this position until his election to the presidency on May 8, 1964.

The retail store operation has four divisions known as: Wrigley, Big Vain, Packer and Plumb in Michigan and Ohio; Humpty Dumpty in Oklahoma; Bettendorf Rapp in Missouri and Illinois and the Ideal Food Stores in Kansas, Texas and the panhandle area of Oklahoma.

IN ADDITION, Allied has a number of subsidiaries including the Abner A. Wolf Grocery Co.; Gold Bell Enterprises, trading stamp and premium operation, and

MRS. HERB CRAW, of the Fox & Hounds Inn, 1111 Woodward, has told us of one of her Chef Harold O'Keefe's favorite recipes that has a good following.

The ingredients go like this (for 6-8 portions): 1 1/2 lbs. lean beef—round or shoulder) cut in 1" cubes; 1 lb. veal kidneys trimmed and cut into 1" cubes; 1 lb. fresh mushrooms cut in quarters and washed; 2 large onions cut in large dice; 1 tsp. ground thyme; 2 or 3 bay leaves; 1 tsp. salt; 1/2 tsp. white pepper; 2 tabl. sps. Lea & Perrins sauce; 12 oz. beef broth or stock;

1 cup cream sherry; one unbaked pie crust, sliced 1/4 size.
Procedure: Wash and parboil kidneys in salted water. Rinse kidneys in cold water and set aside; Braise the beef in a dutch oven or heavy deep skillet.

WHEN BEEF is nicely brown coat with flour, stir and cook 3 or 4 minutes. Now add hot stock or stock and stir again. Add blanched kidneys and remaining ingredients except the wine. Cover and bake in a 375 deg. oven until beef is tender, about 1 1/2 hrs. Add wine during last 20 minutes.

Lick the stew cool, then place in a casserole. Cover the top with unbaked pie crust. Brush with beaten eggs and bake until crust is done.
