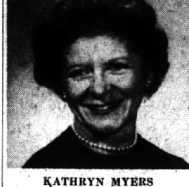

Chairman Receives Grant for Studies At School in France

Kathryn Myers, chairman of the French department of Kingswood School Cranbrook, has been awarded a study grant this summer at the University of Besancon in France.

Miss Myers is one of 20 American teachers of French chosen for the grant which is offered by the French Ministry of Education and which provides for a month (July) of special training in French by audio-visual methods that have been developed by the Centre de Recherche et d'Etude pour la Diffusion de Français.

She is a graduate of Ohio State University and has done graduate work in French at Middlebury College, Ohio State and the University of Michigan. She also studied at the Sorbonne before taking an assignment as the Professor de la Langue et de la Civilisation Americaine at the Lycee de Jeunes Filles at Anney, France.

Miss Myers came to Kingswood in September, 1945.
