Walnut Lake School presented its annual Nola Peasley Award to two students who had done the most in scholarship, citizenship and service to the school and community.

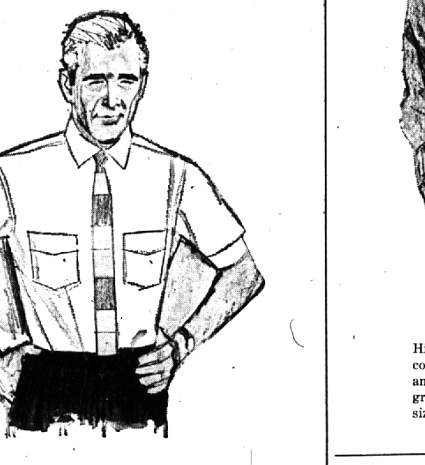
Kathleen Leaf, 11, a member of the sixth grade, and Michael Krause, 12, also a sixth grader, were the recipients.

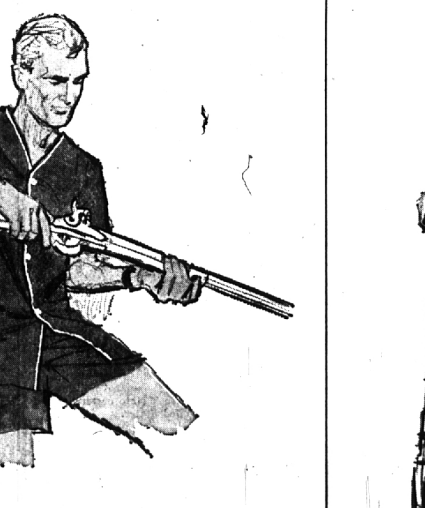

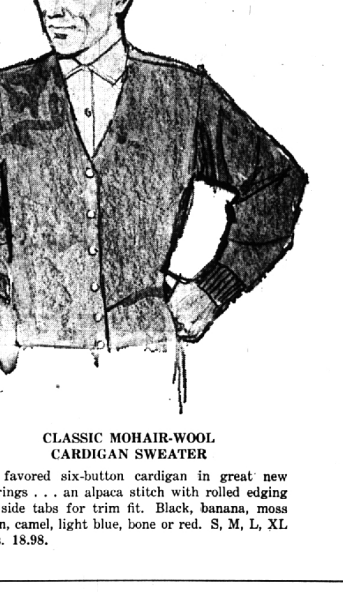

Illustration of a man in a suit.

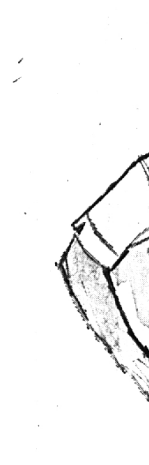


Illustration of a man in a short-sleeved dress shirt and shorts.

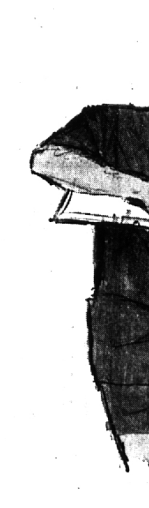

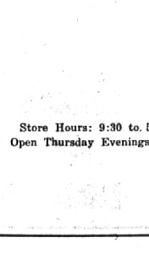
