

Book to Aid Work-Bound Graduates

A counselor's handbook, with strong emphasis on guidance for the student who does not plan to go to college, is being distributed this week by Oakland Schools.

Developed by members of the Oakland Area Counselors Association, the handbook is the first single directory to list the community services, educational, job training and placement resources available in Oakland County and its commuting area.

Only 18 of the 76 pages in the guide are devoted to college information references, lists of Michigan colleges and ways of obtaining financial help for academic education.

"THERE IS a lot of college information readily available to the high school counselor," said Dr. William F. Moorhouse, Oakland

Schools guidance director. "This handbook brings together for the first time the resource material a counselor needs to advise the 40 to 50 per cent of his students who do not go to college. "It is helpful to know, for instance, that from 200 to 400 apprenticeships in the tool and building trades are available every year in the county, and to have some specific information on hand for prospective apprentices."

The book was published by the Guidance Program of Oakland Schools in cooperation with a Federally-sponsored Guidance Project on Counseling for Employment Bound Students. It will be distributed to 255 counselors in the junior and senior high schools of Oakland County.

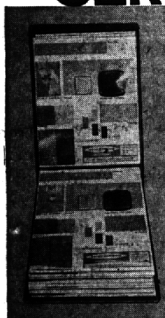

B'field Man To Run for State Office

Denton F. Hassell, 3219 Pebble Lane, Bloomfield Township, will be a candidate for the Republican nomination for state representative in Legislative District No. 47, composed of Birmingham, Bloomfield Hills, Bloomfield Township, Franklin, Bingham Farms, Beverly Hills and Southfield.
