

## 'Back to School' Leads Post-Graduation Plans

What's next for the Class of '64? Almost half of the graduating seniors at eight Oakland County high schools plan to enter college next fall, according to a survey made by the Oakland Guidance Project.

Questionnaires to 2,562 seniors indicated that 1,112 will enroll in a four year college, or university program.

Nine per cent, or 221 young people, want more education but lack the money to pay for it.

A QUARTER OF them will enroll in business or trade schools or obtain on-the-job training. Five per cent do not plan further education or training and ten per cent have not made up their minds.

The schools included in the survey were Pontiac Northern and Pontiac Central High Schools, Waterford-Kettering and Waterford Township High Schools, South Lyon High School, and Royal Oak's Dondora and Kimball High Schools.

Dr. William Moorhouse, Oakland County director of guidance and counseling, said the survey included a quarter of the 10,400 spring graduates of public and private high schools in the county.

A follow-up of the graduates in the survey will be conducted next year to determine how well they have been able to follow through with current plans. Counselors and school administrators intend to use the information to improve school offerings and in the guidance and counseling of students still in school.

Nearly two-thirds of the seniors questioned said they plan to have some kind of job by fall. This includes half of those who plan to go to college. Of the 197 girls who planned to be married before the end of summer, 122 expect to hold jobs outside their new homes.

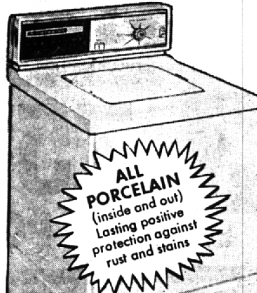

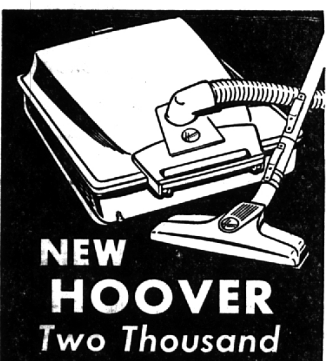
