## Chevy Announces Executive Changes

Retirement of a veteran Chevrolet financial executive and appointment of his successor has been announced by Louis A. Bauer, divisional controller.

Joseph A. Finnie, assistant divisional controller since 1955 and a 38-year veteran with the company, has retired under provisions of the General Motors retirement plan, Bauer said.



Harland D. Harris, financial coordinator of staff activities at the Chevrolet-Central Office since last September, has been named to succeed Finnie, Bauer added.

A NATIVE of Ireland, Finnie, 1079 Pilgrim, Birmingham, attended Christian Brothers high school in Dublin, where he took special courses in finance and accounting. He came to the United States in 1922.

He joined Chevrolet in 1926 as a cost clerk in Tarrytown, N. Y. Three years later he moved to Detroit as a clerk in the office of the president from which he was promoted to traveling auditor and then accountant before returning to Tarrytown as assistant resident controller in 1932. He was advanced to general accounting supervisor that same year, and in 1934 transferred to Buffalo in the same position.

Finnie continued to advance rapidly, serving as resident controller successively at Norwood, Ohio; Janesville, Wis., and Tarrytown from 1934 and 1944. Late that year he was moved to Detroit as assistant to the divisional controller until going to the Chevrolet Flint Manufacturing plant as resident controller in 1945. In 1955, he returned to Detroit as assistant divisional controller, where he served until retirement.

HARRIS, 160 Billingsgate, Bloomfield Township, joined Chevrolet as a payroll clerk at Flint in 1935. After holding various clerical and supervisory positions there and after a year as a traveling auditor, he was named auditor at Chevrolet's Assembly plant at Norwood, Ohio, in 1946. He became general supervisor of accounting at Norwood in 1947 and was assigned to the similar post at the Chevrolet Assembly plant at North Tarrytown, N.Y., in 1951.

Harris was promoted to resident controller of the division's transmission plant at Muncie, Ind., in 1953, to the similar position at the Chevrolet Assembly plant at Atlanta, Ga., in 1955, and to the same post at Chevrolet's Assembly plant at Janesville, Wis., in 1956. He became resident controller at Chevrolet's Flint Manufacturing on March 1, 1959.

A native of Detroit, Harris is a graduate of Baldwin High School, Birmingham, and attended the University of Michigan.

He is executive vice president of Michigan United Fund. He also is a member of the National Budget and Consultation Committee of United Community Funds and Council of America.
