 TAKE NOTICE that the Planning Commission of the Township of Bloomfield will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, the 30th day of July, 1964, at 8:30 o'clock p.m. at the Township Hall, at 4208 Telegraph Road, for considering the following amendment to Ordinance No. 67, as amended, being the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of Bloomfield, as amended in 1961, said amendment reading as follows:

ARTICLE 15—DEFINITION  
 Section 150.9 (1). Stable private: Private stable is a stable or building for the keeping of horses for the non-commercial use of the residents of the principal use and shall not include the keeping of horses for others or for commercial boarding of horses.

ARTICLE IV  
 Section 401. (9) Private Stable, when permitted by the Board of Appeals, for not more than 1 horse on a lot where said lot or parcel is not less than 2 acres in area, and provided further, that for each additional horse stabled thereon, one additional contiguous acre of land shall be provided. All confinement areas and/or stables shall be located in the rear yard. In no instance shall a stable be located nearer than 15 feet to any property line; provided, however, that the latter provision shall not apply to any property line which separates lots of record of at least 120 feet in width which have 3 or more acres in area. No horse shall be allowed to run at large.

## Cancer Tests Given to Residents

Doctors at the Yates Memorial Clinic, a Torch Drive agency, examined 67 Birmingham residents and eight from Bloomfield Hills during the past year.

They were among 11,648 adults who took the cancer tests. Approximately two per cent of those tested were found to have malignancies of which they were unaware.

The Yates Clinic is operated by the Michigan Cancer Foundation, which receives \$200,000 a year from Torch Drive contributions, the largest per capita gift toward fighting cancer of any community in America.
