

Badgers Drop LL Contest

The front-running Badgers in the Continental-Majors ran into some trouble last week, but continued to pace the Little League team in their circuit.

They downed the Trojans 3-1, despite Jim Bone's four-bagger, but then faltered against the Hawkies to drop a 10-3 decision.

JEFF OWENS held the Badgers to just three hits, two in the last inning, as the winners managed nine safeties off loser Bob Brown. The loss brought the Badgers' mark to 8-3, the Hawkies are 4-5-1.

Possible Antlerless Deer Season in Oakland County

Preliminary plans of the Conservation Department point toward a modest harvest of antlerless deer this fall in 10 southern Michigan counties including Oakland, where these animals are doing greatest damage to farm crops and private nurseries.

Previewing recommendations presented to the Conservation Commission for formal action in August, spelled out the urgent need for special seasons in parts of Oakland, Ottawa, Muskegon, Berrien, Kalamazoo, Van Buren, Calhoun, Barry, Eaton and Livingston counties.

The proposed areas are key trouble spots in southern Michigan where whitetails eat up an estimated \$300,000 worth of crops each year. Their highways figure in a large share of the deer-car collisions which have soared to record highs in southern Michigan during recent years.
