Historic Families Buried at Roseland

In the year 1904, a group of Detroit businessmen, realizing the need for a cemetery at the center of population between Detroit and Pontiac, organized a state corporation and founded Roseland Park Cemetery.

A non-sectarian property serving southeastern Michigan and metropolitan Detroit, Roseland Park is marked for thousands of vacationers who enter the Water Wonderland each year.

Locals on Woodward Ave. at Twelve Mile Road at one of the state's busiest intersections, its landscaped acres, winding drives and arching trees create an atmosphere of peace and quiet withdrawn from a busy world.

IF A CEMETERY can be said to have a trademark, "Roseland" is an appropriate one. For more than 40 summers the fence along the half mile Woodward Ave. property line has blazed with countless red, white and pink rambling roses.

On the other days, the Detroit United Railway Interurban line provided a funeral coach to convey funerals to the cemetery entrance at Twelve Mile Road.

While the funeral rites were being conducted, the black electric funeral cars proceeded to Birmingham car barns on North Woodward Ave. at Harmon Street.

ROSELAND HAS many "firsts" in its history. The first community mausoleum in this area was erected in 1915. The area's American Legion Plot was established in Roseland, May 1917.
