(Continued from 1-A) In the audience, expressed the fear that the proposed thoroughfare would endanger the lives of the schoolchildren. The city denied definite plans have been set to use Chester as a leg of the peripheral.

"I'M NOT convinced that the peripheral route is the answer to all our problems," said Breck in an exchange of words with Bennett Root of the school board. Breck suggested that Bates be considered as a leg of the route, although he was in favor of improving Chester without widening it.

"I'M NOT taking a position, you are endorsing the issue," said Breck. Commissioner Carl Ingraham later apologized for Breck on behalf of the city. "He (Breck) has no right to speak in opposition to our plan which has been informally approved by the city council," said Ingraham.

as pawns in this road issue," said a woman representative. "The widening of Chester is going to increase the traffic, and the noise factor (of running cars) must also be considered." "Progress must exist," replied Ingraham. "Otherwise, there will be nothing left for our children when they do grow up."

"This plan has been under study for three years," said Gare. "A four-lane road is necessary even if two of the lanes are used for parking." "We are not contemplating a monster or a high-speed expressway. This road will just move traffic along at 25 mph," said Ingraham.
