Michaels, who lives at 344 W. Brown, is supervisor of the Cranbrook Young People's Art Center, Bloomfield Hills.

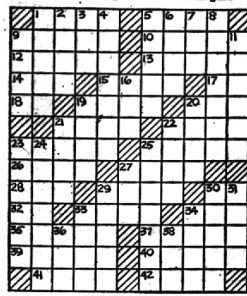

John Murrell, infamous bandit, boasted more crimes than the Harpe brothers and plotted the devastation of New Orleans, Natchez and Memphis.

One chapter in the book gives the history of Josiah Smith's Mormon settlement in Nauvoo, Ill. Although the majority of his group were honest and devout followers of the faith, there nevertheless grew up an evil core of scoundrels who masked under the name of Mormonism and committed dastardly deeds.

MANY OF THE passages of this book are revolting, and one sometimes wonders why even a historian could be so preoccupied with blood and guts.

Nevertheless, they give a picture of the physical terrors which lurked for the early settler who was so unfortunate as to encounter the likes of a Harpe or a Murrell.
