**3 Area Executives Named to JA Board**

Three area executives have been elected to the board of directors of Junior Achievement of Southeastern Michigan at the June stockholders meeting in Detroit.

Beginning these terms in July were John J. Gallagher, 471 N. Williamsburg Road, Birmingham; John C. Secrest, 20570 Leemoor Drive, Birmingham; and Harold G. Warner, 16550 Snowshoe Circle, Bloomfield Hills.

GALLAGHER, 47, is vice president-sales, of the Great Lakes Steel Corp.

Secrest, 42, is vice president and general manager of the newly-created Appliance Division of American Motors Corp.

Warner, 56, is general manager of the Cadillac Motor Car Division and vice president of the General Motors Corp.

Other board members from Bloomfield Hills either recently elected or re-elected include Elnorhart S. Bright, Harvey B. Greene, Milo I. Hector, Donald E. McGaw, Ben D. Mills, Raymond T. Perring, James M. Roche.

Junior Achievement is an educational program for teen-agers between the ages of 15 and 19 that is designed to teach an understanding of the American free enterprise "learn by doing" system. The achievers are recruited through the high schools in the fall and enroll one of the 16 J.A. business centers in the six-county Southeastern Michigan area.

After being divided into groups of 15 or 20, they are assigned a team of three volunteer advisors from business and industry. They then incorporate their group under the laws of Michigan, elect officers, sell stock, and go into production of a product of their own choosing.

These miniature companies then continue to function and prosper until the end of the school year much the way their cousins do in big business. In May the companies are voluntarily liquidated and the stockholders sent a report of company standing. In September, the cycle is started all over again.
