When you garden you meet the nicest people. May I introduce to you Stephen Janovac, 17191 Kinross, Beverly Hills. This gentleman has two years until his official retirement, and

four years ago he discovered his interest for future years in his garden. He has specialized in peonies and hemerocallis (day lilies) for many gardeners. At once he joined the national societies of these specialties so that he regularly receives the latest news on cultural practices as well as well as becomes acquainted with those who feel like he does, as he has selected the flower category he prefers.

Notice that these two flowers perform at different times of the season. In the past I have told you that

many of our finest flower varieties have been developed by the home gardener who crosses one variety with another. Well, you should see Janovac's hemerocallis this time of year.

He has tags on many, many lilies, showing that they have been pollinated this year for new varieties. Also, as you walk along the path with your host, he will be introducing you to many outstanding new lilies he has developed over the years.


AS YOU KNOW you can patent your own developments in the plant realm, and, of course, he has had the state inspected, so he can

ship his specialties to other collectors. Strolling around the perimeter of his garden, here are only a few of the outstanding lilies I admired: Ruffled Star, stays open late at night and is shell pink with ruffled petals; Lexington, deep yellow ruffled petals; Frankly Fabulous, melon-colored; Late and Lovely, deep, deep yellow-colored; President Rice, heavy tall stalks, strong yellow colored, with a very long flowering cycle; Kalon, large yellow petals, which curl back as the day progresses.

Within this garden are 110 name varieties of hemerocallis and 75 varieties of peonies. "Hem" are a
