

YMCA Camp Offers Special Family Week

Both of the Metropolitan Detroit YMCA residence camps have set aside the week prior to Labor Day, Aug. 29 to Sept. 7, for family camping exclusively.

Camp Oblyess, the nearer of the two camps, located near Holly, is less than an hour away from Birmingham.

Camp Niasokone located near Osceola, is some 200 miles from the Detroit area.

Each family who attends the Y family camp is assigned a private, screened cabin which needs only a minimum of clean-up.

MEALS INCLUDING an evening snack are served in the central dining lodge and nursery care for preschoolers is provided twice each day so that members can enjoy the camp program more fully.

Instructors will teach swimming,

boating, sailing, archery, riflery and other activities if desired. Special overnights and canoe trips are planned for the teen-age camper while adult social activities are planned for the evening.

Families may choose the full 10-day camp period from Aug. 29 to Sept. 7, the seven-day period from Aug. 29 to Sept. 5 or the Labor Day weekend of Sept. 5 to 7.

A special family camp reunion

and information night is scheduled at the South Oakland Branch of the YMCA (1016 W. 11 Mile Road, just east of Woodward in Royal Oak) this evening at 7.

Freeway Opens Final Section

The final section of the 40-mile Benton Harbor - to - Holland Freeway has been opened to traffic.

The five-mile section of I-196 extends from an interchange at old US-31 south of Douglas north to an interchange at old US-31 north of Saugatuck.

Competition of the Douglas-Saugatuck section gives motorists

a continuous divided highway from the Michigan-Indiana line north to Whitehall, a distance of 125 miles, with the exception of a four-mile section of two-lane highway at the north edge of Muskegon. The other two lanes at Muskegon are under construction and will be open to traffic about the end of August.
