THE GOLDEN YEARS

It will cost you less money in retirement if you are fairly well off, instead of poor.

It also will cost you less, in many cases, if you will spend some of your money instead of hoarding it.

Walter J. Hanson, who has just retired as an investment banker, thinks he owes it to his fellow-pensioners to pass along some of this advice on money.

"IT IS VERY expensive to be poor," says Mr. Hanson. "In fact it costs so much that only the rich can afford it. The poor can't."

He starts his advice with insurance premiums.

"On life insurance, and certain other kinds, the person who pays premiums quarterly pays larger premiums than the one who pays annually . . . and gets nothing for the extra money. He also uses four stamps, four checks and four envelopes instead of one."

The person who borrows, money on life insurance, he says, also throws money away because the insurance company will charge you more interest on your loan than it will pay you on money of yours it is holding. He explains it is usually the poorer people

who have to borrow on insurance.

"A HOUSE mortgage is the most dramatic example of all. All sorts of people who have savings and other investments will go out willy-nilly and get a mortgage on their home, paying up to six and a half per cent for the money while getting only three and a half or four per cent on the money they are holding back.

"The poor man must get a mortgage because he has no savings probably winds up paying three per cent per year more for his house than the rich man who just goes out and buys it.

"It probably figures much more than this when you consider the insurance tab on a mortgaged

HANSON mentioned installment purchases, but didn't want to go into details except to say that the person who buys on an installment account sometimes pays up to eight per cent more than the person who buys on a monthly charge, account or for cash.

Hanson cited three areas where a retired person can save money by spending money.

"Air conditioning is a big one. The amount of money people pay to escape the misery of heat—cold pills, nerve medicine, soft drinks, ice cream, ice tea, fans, trips to movie houses, wrinkled and stained clothes, and laundry—could pay for air conditioning in a year.

"AND a food freezer. The couple owning a big food freezer and having the energy to pick up bargain foods can pay for a freezer with what they save on food in one year . . .

"And a will. People who won't pay \$50 for a will sometimes lose as much as \$2,000 in court costs for their heirs. They never know it because they aren't around when the bills come in."

Most retired people nowadays are halfway between being rich and poor. Hanson's advice is pertinent.

Flying somewhere for vacation? If it is a long one, get up and walk around a bit every now and then, the Michigan Heart Association suggests, to keep the circulation in your legs from slowing down. Stretch your legs on motor trips, too.
