Preschool Confab Set for Teachers

All elementary and secondary teachers new to the Birmingham Public Schools will attend a four-day Preschool Workshop beginning Monday, Aug. 31. Returning teachers are also welcome to attend.

The purpose of the workshop is to give the new teaching staff an opportunity to become familiar with their teaching materials. The workshop will emphasize all phases of the academic program. The all-day sessions will include objectives, specific content, use of instructional materials and modern methods of instruction.

THE WORKSHOP on Monday at Torry Elementary School is for elementary teachers. Following registration and coffee in the morning, teachers will have workshop sessions in the areas of reading, social studies and mathematics.

Teachers will meet in three groups, (1) kindergarten through second grade, (2) grades three and four, and (3) grades five and six. The Monday afternoon elementary sessions will cover the following: Community Resources, Fritz Pina, principal, Adams Elementary School and 1963 director, Community Resources Summer Workshop; physical education, Frank Whitney, coordinator; physical education and athletics; art, Phil Savaglio, associate art teacher.

BOTH elementary and secondary teachers will attend the Tuesday sessions. The purpose of the morning session at Seaholm High School is acquaint teachers with the central office services.

Superintendent Dr. John Blackhall Smith will welcome the teachers and present an overview of the school system administration.

The following central office administrators will speak briefly: "The Community," Walter Piel, administrative assistant; "The Department of Instruction," Daniel Nesbitt, deputy superintendent; "Buildings, Cafeterias, and Transportation," Norman Wolfe, assistant superintendent; "Personnel," Kenneth Nagley, director of personnel; "Finance," Lloyd Van Buskirk, director of finance; "Insurance," Dr. Smith.

Following lunch, elementary teachers will report back to Torry

School for workshop sessions. Arnold Bernat, coordinator of music, will talk about the music program.

SECONDARY teachers will return to Seaholm High School following lunch. Daniel Nesbitt, deputy superintendent, will introduce the new teachers to the building principals and coordinating staff.

Teachers will then meet with their respective building principals in previously assigned rooms at Seaholm. After these meetings, teachers will meet with their subject area coordinators or department chairmen.

On Wednesday morning, elementary teachers will continue with grade level meetings in reading, science and mathematics. Secondary teachers will continue meetings with their respective coordinators or department chairmen. In the afternoon, all teachers will report to their assigned buildings.

On Thursday morning, all teachers will report to the Little Theater, Seaholm High School. The morning program will include information about special services for students and introduction of community agencies. The workshop will conclude with a luncheon at Seaholm where the teachers will be the guests of the Birmingham Education Association.

Candidate Plans Barbecue Outing

Bham Commissioner Views UP Manpower Retraining Program

Upper Peninsula manpower retraining programs are the shining examples of all Michigan programs, said Thomas Roumell of Dearborn, director of the Michigan Employment Security Commission (MESC), after a first-hand look Aug. 5 at Michigan Technological University's facilities.

Roumell, three of the four commissioners and other MESC officials toured Tech's Ford Forestry Center at Alberta and visited a surveying course for civil engineering aides in progress on the Houghton campus.

Tech's Ford Center is the site of past and future manpower retraining programs under the Manpower Development and Training Act (MDTA). In addition to the surveying course, Tech's MDTA programs include those for entry-level sawyers, lumber graders, forestry aides, diesel mechanics and draftsmen, with others scheduled to come.

Among those in the inspection party were Commissioner Chester A. Cain of Birmingham.
