

# Set Gospel Crusade For Grace Baptist

## St. James Youth Camp Attracts 35

Thirty-five young campers in grades 9 through 12 will leave St. James Episcopal Church, Birmingham, on Sunday for the St. James Youth Camp held this year at Camp Cavell.

The camp is located on Lake Huron with 1,400 feet of lake frontage and 40 acres of woods and meadows. All camp facilities are open to the campers including horseback riding.

The Youth Camp will be under the supervision of the St. James clergy. The Rev. Kenneth H. Gass, Rector; the Rev. W. Eugene Snookell and the Rev. Peter G. Watkins, assisted by adult counselors from the parish and members of the camp staff.

For a period each morning there will be group discussion, topics ranging from prayer to politics. The young people will be encouraged to lead the discussions.
