First Aid Director Is Set for the Fair

Preparations for the 115th Michigan State Fair, Aug. 28 through Sept. 7, are gaining momentum. Among the supervisory staff members getting set for the "granddaddy of fairs" is Mrs. Marion Richards, of 1651 Spotswood, Bloomfield Hills, director of first aid.

A registered nurse in her 17th

year as head of health services for the State Fair, Mrs. Richards knows that the 10 days and 11 nights of the exposition will be busy ones for the eight nurses who make up her staff.

The first aid station, which will be in new quarters this year, expects to care for more than 100 patients a day—on special days as many as 300.

LAST YEAR, the nurses treated 1947 fair-goers suffering everything from headaches, blistered feet and upset stomachs to faints, abrasions, fractures, insect bites and nosebleeds. Leading among ailments were headaches (827) and blistered feet (224).

Mrs. Richards and her group are on duty each day of the State Fair before the gates of the Fairgrounds open.

They are responsible, too, for all personnel who handle food at the State Fair.

Y Family Camping Set For Labor Day Holiday

How often have you heard "mom" at the end of a vacation day. "This has been no fun for me. I've just continued my usual week of cooking, washing dishes, and looking after the kids."

A cabin by the lake can be wonderful for Dad and the youngsters but "poor mom" often spends her day cooking on an inadequate stove and washing dishes without the help of hot water and modern appliances.

Family camping is becoming more and more popular, according to YMCA statistics.

Each year increasing numbers of families are vacationing at lake side or sea shore. Their equipment varies from a simple tent to a five-ton trailer packed with the latest in camping gear.

Some have found such camping more tiring than relaxing, however, for often one must travel hundreds of miles to seek out the best camping areas. (alas, often they are already filled to capacity!)

YMCA CAMPING in recent years has been expanded to include not only the city boy who needs two weeks of outdoor life but the entire family as well. Many "Y" camp directors feel, in fact, that the most productive camp experience can be enjoyed when the family attends as a unit.

Both of the Metropolitan Detroit YMCA residence camps set aside the week prior to Labor Day (Aug. 29 to Sept. 7) for family camping exclusively.

Camp Ohyesa, the nearest of the two camps, located near Holly, is only an hour away from the metropolitan area. Camp Nisakome located near Osceola is situated in the beautiful lake region in the northern part of the lower peninsula some 200 miles (3 1/2 hours by expressway) from the Detroit area.

EACH FAMILY who attends "Y" family camp is assigned a private, screened cabin. There is a minimum of clean-up necessary—just a daily "sweep-out". Meals (including an evening snack) are served in the central dining lodge.

Nursery care for pre-schoolers is provided twice each day in order that mom can enjoy the program of the camp fully.

Program at "Y" family camp is flexible. Competent instructors are on hand to teach swimming, boating, sailing, archery, riflery, and a myriad of other activities.

However, all program is offered on a "take it or leave it" basis. (Many of the Dads, in fact, spend the greatest part of their time snoozing under a shade tree).

Special overnights and canoe trips are planned to keep the teenage camper interested and busy. Social activities are planned for the adults after the youngsters are tucked in bed.

"SUCH A YMCA family camp is within the budget of all, according to their statistics. Families may choose the full 10-day camp period from Aug. 29 to Sept. 7 or the seven day period from Aug. 29 to Sept. 5 or, for those who have no additional vacation time coming, the Labor Day weekend of Sept. 5 to 7th.

For family camp rates and other information, residents may call Mrs. Betsy Pratt of the Birmingham branch of the "Y" from 9 to 5 any week day.
