Local Explorers Attend National Scout Conference

The second National Explorer Delegate Conference of the Boy Scouts of America, held at the University of Kansas, Lawrence, Kan., began Aug. 16 and continued through Aug. 20.

The conference was the largest gathering of Explorer Scouts in the history of the organization. It was attended by 1,200 high school delegates representing the 315,000 Explorers in the country.

The theme of the conference was "Seek the Truth in All Things." The delegates discussed such questions as, "What are the responsibilities of youth related to understanding and respect of the law, service, patriotism, American heritage and religion?"

WHAT ARE the responsibilities of youth related to friendship with other countries, education, personal fitness and exploration into vocation? What responsibilities do Explorers have toward the improvement of their program and the Boy Scouts of America?

The Detroit Area Council had eight boys representing them from the Detroit area. The delegates included Tom Bailey, 4564 Echo Road, Bloomfield Hills, and Robert Freehan, 17500 Beechwood, Beverly Hills, advisor to the group.

THE EIGHT delegates boarded the New York Central train at 7 a.m. Aug. 15 in Detroit and then picked up the Santa Fe Chief in Chicago which took them to Lawrence.

On Sunday, the 16th, the delegates checked into dormitories on the campus of the University of Kansas. From Monday until Thursday the delegates from the Detroit Area Council, along with the rest of the delegates, attended discussions, debates and skills contests.

Thursday evening the Detroit delegates boarded a train for home and arrived back in Detroit Friday afternoon.

County Accepts Final Report on Airport Plans

An aviation report recommending that Oakland County and Pontiac combine their resources in developing a Pontiac Municipal Airport was accepted last week by the Oakland County Board of Supervisors committee on aviation.

Action was not taken on any of the suggestions made by Leigh Fisher Associates Inc., San Francisco airport consultants.

The three-month, \$10,000 plan contained no provisions for commercial air traffic, stating that scheduled air service in and out of Pontiac is no longer necessary due to the proximity of an easy access to Detroit and Flint air terminals.

A MASTER plan and development program for the county-owned Allen Airport in Pontiac and Orion townships was also included in the request of the committee who anticipated a possible future overloading of Pontiac Municipal Airport.

The consulting firm estimated the Pontiac Airport project could cost \$8,564,410; the development of the Allen Airport, \$6,979,372.

Federal and state aid would reduce the county's cost to \$3,728,000 for the Allen site; and the city and county would share \$3,807,717 of the cost for the city airport.
