Mississippi Seating Dispute Aided by 2 State Delegates

Two members of Michigan's delegation to the Democratic National Convention played a leading role in solving a last-minute dispute over the seating of the Mississippi delegations last week.

Cong. Neil Stabler and Sen. Philip A. Hart both spoke from the podium Tuesday night in a session marked by conflict over a seating of two opposing delegations from Mississippi.

Just before the evening meeting opened, the Mississippi credentials dispute sparked a lively debate in the Michigan delegation caucus.

Stabler, Democratic candidate for governor, introduced speaker of the House of Representatives, John McCormack (D-Mass).

"WE DEMOCRATS have a reason to be proud of our party and our record. We have kept our promises," Stabler said.

The Ann Arbor businessman went on to point out that this session of congress "has proved itself truly responsive to the will of the people."

Pointing to successes in the Civil Rights Bill, the War on Poverty Bill, the tax cut, the Peace Corps, urban renewal and the nuclear test ban treaty, Stabler gave high praise to the "firm and fair" leadership of Speaker McCormack.

Senator Hart made the concluding speech in the presentation of the 1964 Democratic platform to the delegates.

AFTER PAYING tribute to the memory of the late President Kennedy, Sen. Hart urged that "we honor his memory by devoting ourselves to the people."
