Grant to Expand MSU International Studies Program

Michigan State University has received a \$250,000 Ford Foundation grant to expand its undergraduate offerings in international studies. The funds also will finance the development of a new program in comparative cultures at the undergraduate level.

Dr. Ralph H. Smuckler, associate dean of MSU's International Programs, pointed out that programs under the grant will be devoted to the undergraduate curriculum, while earlier grants from the foundation assisted graduate and faculty research.

Funds from the grant will go to the University College Department of Social Science, College of Arts and Letters, the University College humanities program, and for international curriculum planning in agriculture, education and engineering.
