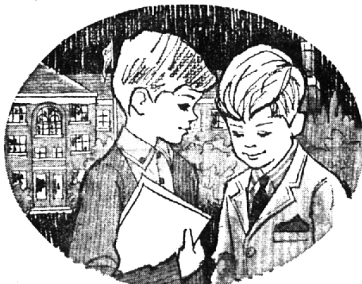
A RECEPTION at the Carriage House, Rotaford Inn, followed the ceremony.
