## Cranbrook Academy Children's Classes Taking Applications

Applications are being accepted for the fall term of children's art classes in the Young People's Art Center, sponsored by the Cranbrook Academy of Art Galleries. Young people seven through 17 may enroll in the classes which begin Sept. 29. Classes are divided by ages and are held in the YPAAC Gallery below the library. THE FALL session continues for 10 weeks. Classes meet for 90 minutes after school on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. There are three 90-minute classes offered Saturdays. YPAAC instructor is Glen Michaels of Birmingham who received his MFA degree from Cranbrook Academy of Art. Classes work in a wide variety of media.

## OU Courses Scheduled in Birmingham

The Community House, Birmingham, and Oakland University, Rochester, have again joined forces to bring two courses to area residents this fall.

With the theme "Using Leisure Creatively", The Community House continues its efforts to offer a diversified curriculum with qualified instructors. "Problems of Literary Censorship," taught by Oakland University's Richard E. Quintance, Ph.D., begins a 10-week session Oct. 1.

Providing an opportunity to discuss the controversial relationship of pornography, cultural awareness and public welfare, this course will include such examples as "The Carpetbaggers," "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?" "Catcher in the Rye" and many others. The belief that early exposure to good literature will outweigh interest in other types will also be explored.

W. W. KENT, JR., M.Mus., will instruct 10 weeks of "Music Appreciation," beginning Sept. 30. High-fidelity recordings significant to various periods in musical history will serve as audible aids. Included will be study of musical thought, style and structure, their sociological and philosophical implications and correlative contemporary parallels.

The Community House (Bates and Townsend) is offering 34 other classes in addition to the two Oakland University courses.

Registration began Tuesday and continues through this week.




## Birmingham Women Head Reception for Design Exhibition


