# Citizens for Goldwater Cite Campaign Goals

The Michigan Citizens for Goldwater and Miller, an organization designed to appeal to voters regardless of party affiliation, will play an active part in the presidential campaign on a state-wide basis, Crichton D. Holden, state chairman, announced today.

At the same time Holden announced establishment of state headquarters at 8774 Northland Center, Southfield, and appointments to campaign positions, including district chairmen.

"We know there are hundreds of independents and Democrats anxious to help promote the Goldwater candidacy," Holden said.

"THE MICHIGAN Citizens for Goldwater and Miller will cooperate with the regularly established Republican state, county, and district committees to achieve their mutual goals insofar as possible and practicable. Our activities will at all times be coordinated with the Republican State Central Com-

mittee to avoid duplication and confusion.

"Within a short time we will be organized down to ward and precinct levels. Our efforts will be directed toward persuading voters of all political persuasions, ages, sexes, and economic levels that election of Goldwater and Miller is in the best interests of all citizens.

"To this end, public meetings and rallies will be organized and supported with outstanding speakers provided by a Speakers' Bureau," he added.

Holden will be assisted on the state level by Mrs. James Greenway of St. Clair as campaign secretary; Mrs. Robert Jones, Grand Lodge, State Central coordinator; Mrs. Stewart Rice, Southfield, headquarters office manager.

## AT WORLD'S FAIR

## GM's 'Futurama' Sets New Attendance Mark

The General Motors Futurama exhibit at the New York World's Fair set a new attendance record Friday when the 13,180,001th person stepped across the threshold.

The event marked the greatest number of persons ever attracted by an industrial exhibit within one year anywhere in the world.

The previous record—13,180,000—was set by GM's "Futurama I" exhibit during the first year of the 1939-40 New York World's Fair.

The most popular attraction at the 1939-40 World's Fair just as the Futurama is one of the most popular attractions at the current fair.

The history of world's fairs dates back 113 years, to the Crystal Palace Exposition in London in 1851.

CONCERNING the new record, Fair President Robert Moses said: "I congratulate General Motors for creating an exhibition which, measured by attendance, has proved to be the most popular ever devised by industry."

"The Futurama is an outstanding combination of imagination, foresight and technical excellence which well merits the public acclaim and patronage it has received."

"The New York World's Fair 1964-65 is particularly proud that this new, international mark was established by one of its exhibitors," said Moses. "It is one of the many worthwhile accomplishments we feel the fair will attain. By the time the fair closes in 1965, the Futurama promises to amass a visitor total which will stand as a challenge for years to come."

THE FAIR itself has also surpassed the attendance total realized during the first year of its predecessor's two year run.

With 140 days completed, it has attracted 27,524,954 visitors. During its 186-day stand in 1959, the fair attendance totaled 25,817,265.

General Motors scheduled a number of events in honor of its 13,180,001 Futurama visitor.

GM has been entertaining and informing the public through a variety of presentations since the company was founded in 1908. It has participated in the National Automobile Show since its inception and has independently staged a number of large-scale entertainments.

The "Parade of Progress," the "Train of Tomorrow," the "Powerama," the "Preview of Progress," and several "Motorama" extravaganzas have been viewed by more than 100,000,000 across the country.

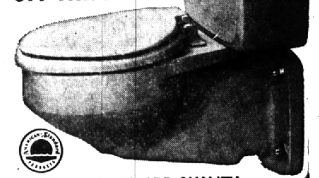

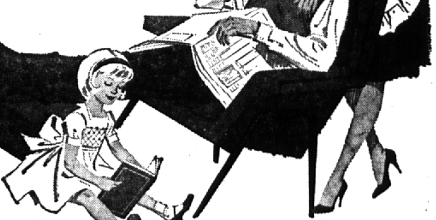
