Spending the week end with the family were Miss Christy Wells and Miss Linda Cook, both of Springfield, O.

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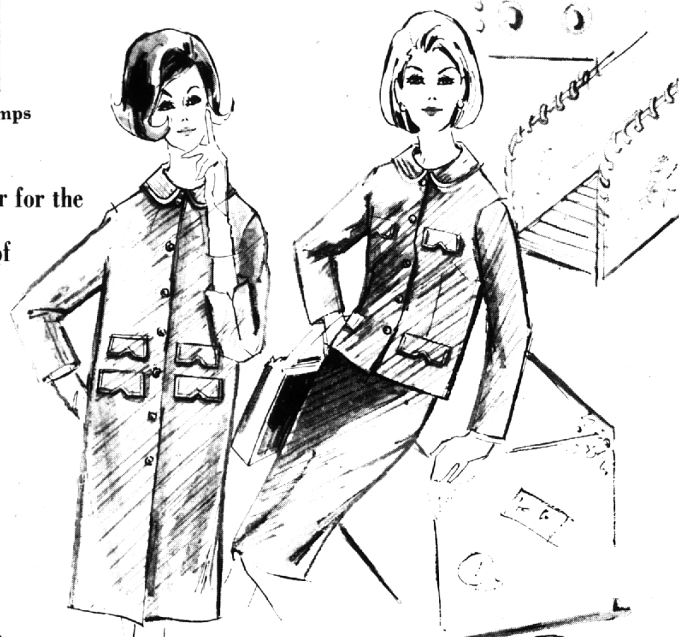
