## ORDINANCE NO. 78

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 4 OF THE VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS.

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordains:

Section 1.01. That Ordinance No. 4 be and the same hereby is amended by the addition of 2 new sub-sections reading as follows:

ling as follows:

Section 95. It is unlawful for a person to operate a motor vehicle upon a highway or street in a speed contest or for the purpose of making a speed record, including that commonly known as a drag race, whether from a standing start or otherwise over a measured or unmeasured distance, the object of which is to better or defeat 1 or more contestants on the basis of an elapsed time, superior performance or speed.

Section 96. No person shall sell or offer for sale on any highway or street any vehicle manufactured or assembled after January 1, 1965, except those exempt from certificate of title requirements under the provisions of Section 216 of Chapter 2 of Act 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as amended, being the Michigan Vehicle Code, unless it is equipped with 2 rear stop lamps except on motorcycle or motor-driven cycle meeting the requirements of Section 637 of said Act 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as amended. Any motorcycle or motor-driven cycle shall be required to have 1 rear stop lamp.

Section 2.01. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance which is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall become effective immediately upon publication.


