Bloomfield Township

Background

- This material was prepared by members of the Bloomfield Historical Society (BHS) to document the status of historic houses in Bloomfield Township as it existed in **2006**. There will be no attempt to continually add new Century Houses to the list as time advances. (However, there may be an additional document prepared in the future to commemorate other houses that will have turned 100 years old since 2006.)
- In July 2006 the assessors office of Bloomfield Township presented a list of Houses in the Township that were (estimated to be) over 100 years old.
 - The list contained 41 houses. Many were farmhouses from the middle to late 1800s.
 - The dates came from the "Field Sheets" that the Township maintains for each dwelling. These dates are only estimates. Some century houses may have been missed.
 - Houses in the City of Bloomfield Hills and Birmingham were not included in the list.
- As of the writing of this summary (January 2017):
 - 4 houses have been demolished and
 - One (the Craig Log Cabin) was moved to a new location
- Some houses have been significantly modified with additions, etc. over the 100 – plus years
- **Photographs** were taken of each house from the road.
- The Location of each house was marked on a **1908 Map** of Bloomfield Township.
- List of the **Owners** of the property as are recorded on historic property ownership maps for: 1857, 1872, 1896, 1908 1927 and 1930; were recorded on a property Questionnaire page.
- A visit was made to the Archives of Michigan in Lansing where the **Rural Property Inventory** record from 1938 for each house, if available, was copied.
- A few of the houses have had a significant amount of research done on them.
 - Several have been the subject for Local History / Local Resources (LH/LR) Series Presentations
 - Some have been written about in the BHS Newsletter, *Legacy*.
- This material was initially placed in a **3-Ring Binder** for future reference.
- In 2017 the material in the 3-ring binder was **Scanned**, the pages printed, and then bound into this document for reference use in the Local History section of the Bloomfield Township Public Library (BTPL).

"Hadsell Pond & Hadsell residence. View toward north."

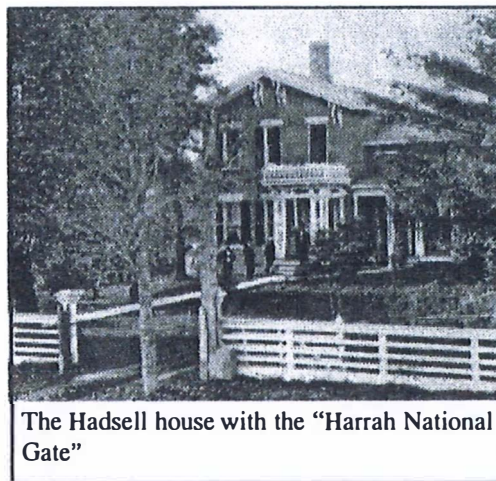
Asa B. Hadsell was born 31 Jan 1796 in Barkhamsted, Litchfield, Connecticut. The family moved west, settling in Vestal, Broome County, New York. In 1818, Asa set out for Michigan, and in August 1819, arrived in Pontiac, where he took employment with the Pontiac Company, working on the first dam and the saw and grist mills. Asa made his first land purchase 17 Sep 1821 with John Cochran, 100 acres being the southeast quarter of Section 3 in Bloomfield Township. He then traded that property on 17 Oct 1822, for 50 acres in part of the northeast quarter of Section 4 of Bloomfield Township owned by Luther and Polly Sowles.

On 4 Jul 1822, Asa married Elizabeth Todd, and they built a sturdy one-room log cabin on the south end of their land facing east. There, they raised two sons, Charles and Edmund until Elizabeth died 5 Nov 1846. On 18 Nov 1850, Asa married his second wife, Fanny E. Adams. Fanny also bore two children, Albert Gallatin, and a daughter, Addie Byron, and now the log cabin held a family of six. By April 1857, Hadsell was contracting with Johnson Prall, a well-known architect and builder, to build a larger house. In June, Asa purchased on contract seventy thousand bricks at \$5 per thousand for a total sum of \$350.00, and construction of the red brick house soon began.

Asa continued to increase his land holdings, purchasing property all over the county. He owned several parcels in Bloomfield and Pontiac Townships, including a "Store House" on Saginaw street in Pontiac, as well as parcels in Orion, Auburn Hills and even Lambton

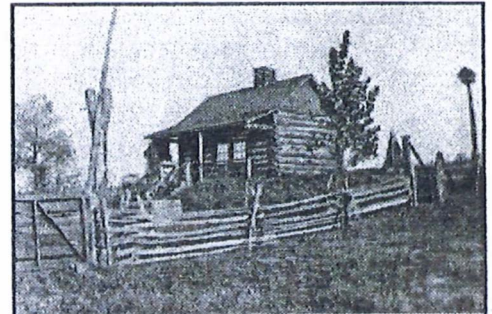
County, Ontario. He also continued to improve his homestead. In 1866, Asa received a "Farm Right" certifying that he purchased the right to "manufacture and use, on his Farm in E. Bloomfield and in no other place or places, the Farm Gate known as the "Harrah National Gate"." By 1872, the Hadsell homestead consisted of 34 acres, and grew to include the "brick dwelling and frame barn...with the surrounding yards, orchards, garden", as well as "pasture fields known as the swamp lot and wood pasture".

Asa B. Hadsell died 28 Jun 1879 with an estimated value, both real and personal, of \$25,000. His bequeathed to his son Albert, the farm on Section 3 consisting of 149 acres, where Albert resided at the time. In addition, Albert was to receive all the tools, implements, horses, stock and other personal property which belonged to Asa at the time of his death, subject to the dower right of his "beloved widow", Fanny E. Hadsell. His son, Edmund, who resided in California was to receive \$1,000 and his grandson, Charles E. Hadsell \$500, with the remainder of his estate, both real and personal to his wife Fanny, whom he named executrix.

After Asa's death, Fanny resided in the Hadsell home until her death 3 Apr 1897. After her death, Albert and his family moved back to the homestead, making improvements, and in 1898, the "swamp lot" or bog, was cleared of dirt, and an artificial lake called Hadsell Pond was created. Albert eventually sold the acreage in Section 3, and by 1916, it had become the South Bloomfield Highlands Subdivision. When Albert died in 1917, a "Statement of Property" valued the 38 acre homestead at Bloomfield at \$15,000.

The Hadsell house, was first built along the Saginaw Trail, which eventually became Woodward Avenue. Woodward began as a narrow 18-foot road with an interurban rail track running along the east side. By 1916, it had been paved all the way from Detroit to Pontiac, and in 1923, a measure was adopted to widen Woodward Avenue to make it the first "super highway". This would include creating four lanes, with provision for the interurban rail between two strips of concrete, measuring a total width of 204 feet. "When the widening of Woodward Avenue began many farms were being tilled along its distance between Pontiac and Birmingham and between Birmingham and Royal Oak. Today scarcely a farm remains along the entire 13 miles." The effect of Wider Woodward on the Hadsell farm as the loss of a large portion of land fronting Woodward, resulting in the removal of the fence and changing the entrance to the home.

The Hadsell house still stands today, just south of St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, with the red brick painted white and a newer home where the barn used to stand. The intricate cornice brackets can still be seen underneath the roof, but the large Victorian porch and detailed front entrance is long gone. It is not known when the log cabin was destroyed, although a 1906 news clipping featured a photograph of the interior, and a 1916 atlas shows a building located on the south side of the pond. After Albert's death in 1917, the homestead was eventually sold off and subdivided. Today, the home sits on a hill overlooking the Hadsell Pond which remains as a silent reminder of the once rustic farm the Hadsell family called home for over 75 years.

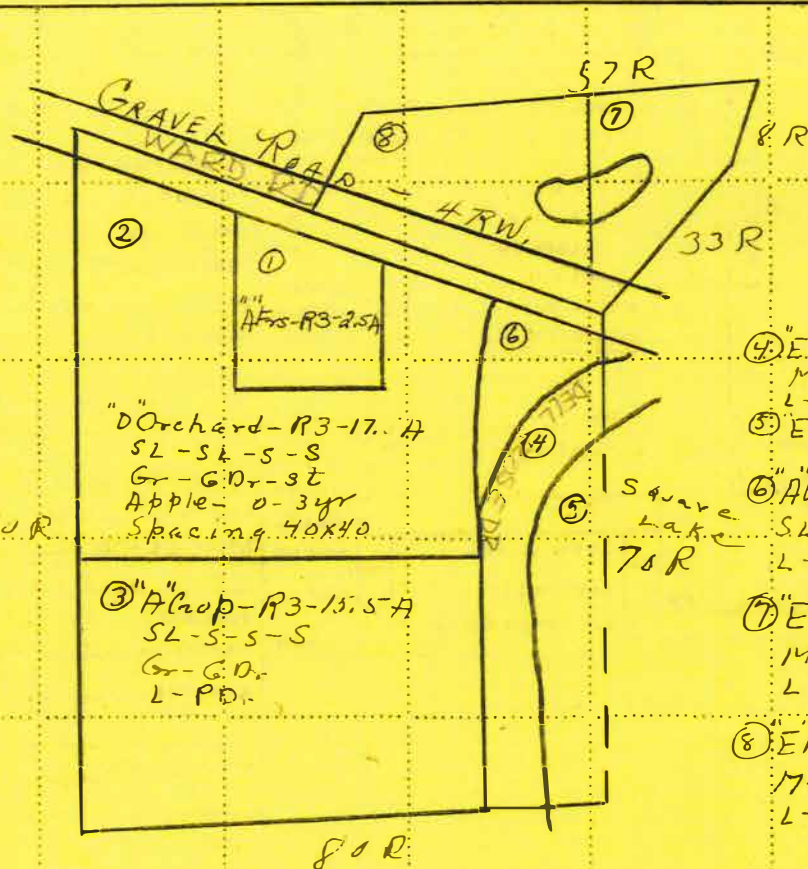

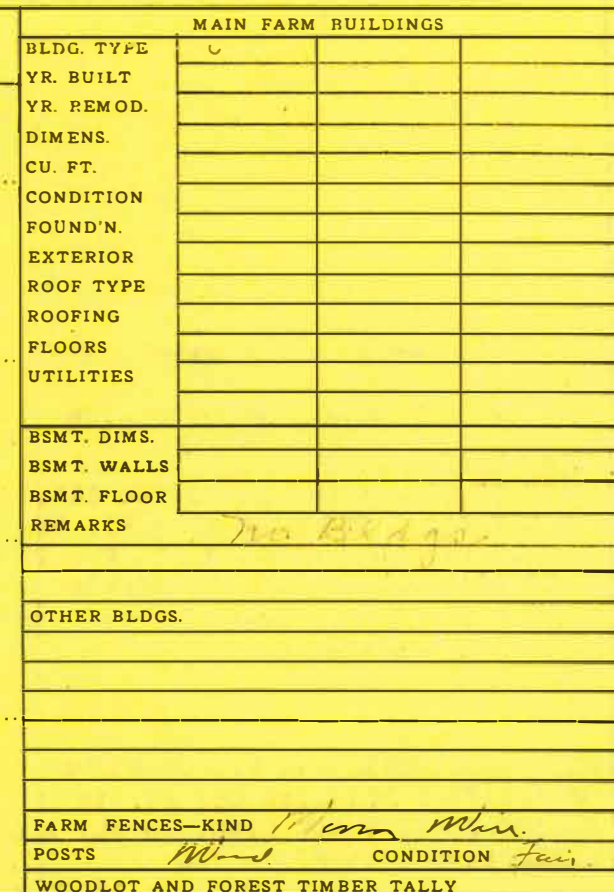

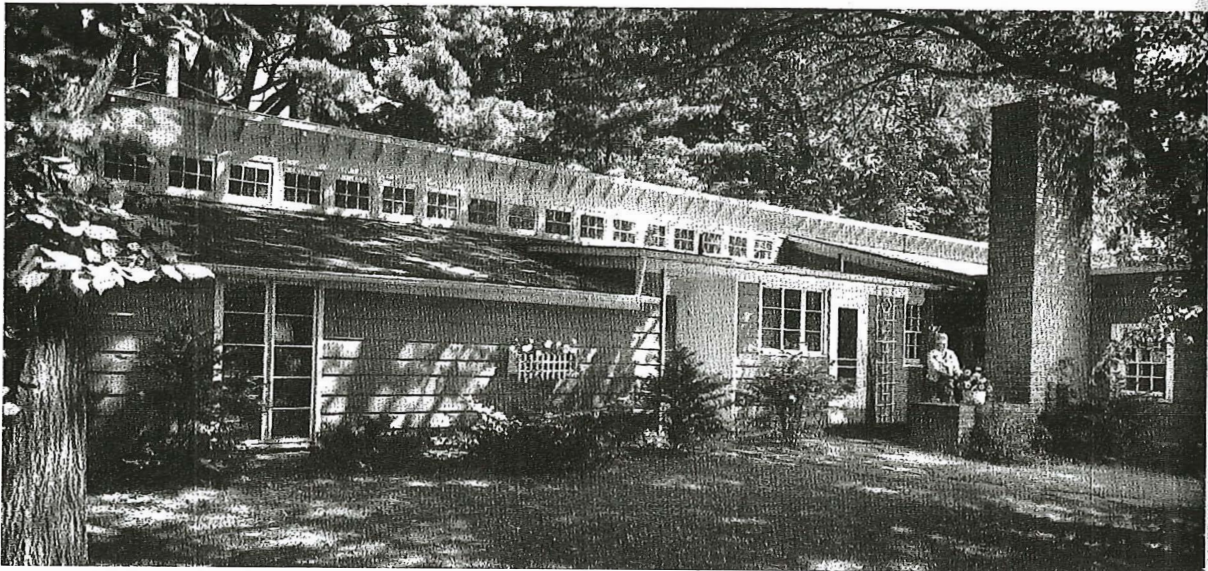

When was the House Built?

I have no hard evidence as to when the house was originally built. The house is not shown on the 1872 map but is on the 1896 map. This leads me to believe the house was built sometime between those dates. It's possible that the house was built earlier and was missed on the map but I think that is less likely.

1. In 1865, a bill of complaint was brought to the Oakland County court by the R. Madden to resolve an issue of the division of land belonging to Nelson Madden who died in 1855. This was brought when one of the heirs (John Madden) sold his 9/64 interest to Samuel Hollingshead before the property was legally divided. After the division in 1866 the parcel this house is located on went to Mary Madden (*who married C. Beach one year later in 1867*). I don't think anyone would start building a house until the land division was finalized.
2. My best guess is the house was built sometime between 1867 and 1886 by C. Beach, J. Phipps, or O'Dell. I found an entry in the 2/10/1887 issue of *Eccentric* under *Town Line Tootings* that says "Moses Shug bought the O'Dell Farm". It sounds like there would be a house on the property if it was called a farm instead of land, property or orchard. It's not hard evidence but it could mean that the house was on the property at least by 1887 and possibly earlier.
3. The 1880 document for the sale of the property to the O'Dells shows John Phipps and wife with a mortgage. I don't know if that means anything. Could it mean that a house was on the property at this time?
4. A mason who built the fireplace and chimney when we did our addition evaluated the foundation and said it looked to him like approximately an 1870-1880 time frame by the style of the foundation. At some point a passageway was opened in the foundation and an addition to the basement was dug out and added which allows the thickness of the wall and type of construction to be seen. In this area along one wall the house extends over the foundation about 4 ft. to another non-weight bearing foundation that was not very deep and formed over a domed cistern. I recently had to have this repaired as it was crumbling.
5. The house had major renovation in 1951. Back to back fireplaces, a bay window, the stonework on the front of the house, and an open banister to the 2nd floor was added. It looks like the roof boards were taken off, the rafters replaced and the old wide roof boards put back up. I think the cedar shake was put on at this time. White clapboard is underneath the cedar shake on the original part of the house. See Photo. At some point the House was raised and put on 2 rows of cinder blocks to give more headroom to the basement.
6. An addition was done in 1968 – Midwest Builders
7. We did an addition in 1987 - Building Associates

Miscellaneous Notes and Facts

Many years ago a man named Robert Ferguson came by the house and said he used to visit his sister Doris Ferguson who lived on the farm that was here. He said she was there approximately 1934-1946. She and her husband rented it from Briggs. He said that the farm had a 17 acre orchard, 300 chickens, 30 pigs and 17 cows. He showed me where the chicken coop used to be and said the barn was approximately where Kentmoor Rd is now. He said there were no fireplaces in the house at that time. He had two photos from that time to show me. One showed the front of the house and the other was of his sister with the barn in the background. I copied the photos and they are attached. The previous address was 1262 Square Lake Rd. He was the person that told me about the Linton school being moved.

My old notes show a transaction on August 20, 1870 - R. Maden to C. Beach - (Lot #2 & 3 of E ½ of ?) This would make sense as it explains the mystery of how C. Beach eventually owned 69 acres. I don't know where this information came from. I must have found a document somewhere. During my recent search I could not find it again. I have good clear copies of every other document but this one. Perhaps you might be able to figure out where this document could be.

Over the years while gardening around the house, I have found a number of artifacts from the previous residents including a clay pipe, a toy soldier that appears to be from WW1, 2 axe heads, a brass water faucet, horse teeth, various bits of china and glass, and tractor parts.

During dry weather the outline of the chicken coop and another outbuilding can be seen. Also years ago I noticed a slight depression in the front lawn very near the corner of Square Lake Rd. and Kentmoor. I dug down a couple of feet and discovered a circular stone wall going down. It was filled with dirt and some trash I filled in the hole thinking that I may excavate again one day. Today a depression can still be seen where this well or cistern is.

Another bit of info I found not directly related to the house is about the Maddens. Alpheus Madden (b.) was married to Eunice Beach (b. 8/19/1786) their son was Nelson Madden the 2nd owner of the property where the house is. Nelson Madden had a son named Alpheus Madden (*the brother of Mary Madden who married C. Beach*). Alpheus Madden enlisted in Co. F, Fifth infantry, August 6, 1861 at Fort Wayne and died Alexandria, Va. Nov. 24 1861. His name is on the soldier's monument in Birmingham.

5841 Wing Lake Road (lot 2)

1821 - 1832

Historical research regarding dates and facts can be both reward- and frustrating. This is the case concerning the house presently owned by Laura and Henry Hager.

The original portion of the building is believed to have been built by one of the earliest settlers in Bloomfield Township, the Honorable Austin Eli Wing. It was a modest, early-American farmhouse of two stories with a firm foundation of native stone dug from the knoll on which it stands.

It's not difficult to pinpoint later additions: the 19th century addition on the north side and, early in the Summer resort era of Wing Lake, the south end, 1907. (Last addition was verified by the Hagers when, tearing out a non-bearing wall in 1970, shortly after they purchased the house from Alton C. Macey and wife, Janet May, they discovered an electrical permit from the City of Pontiac, dated 1903.)

However, on checking through the Assessor's Field Sheet with Bloomfield Township official, Carlos Brown, only two recordings were found: 1834, and a permit for alterations, 1970. According to Mr. Brown, the first recording was probably nothing more than an educated guess, and does not verify the original house was built at that time. It may well have been constructed prior to 1834 for records in the early 19th century were haphazard at best, and in many instances where settlers built in remote and isolated areas, non-existent.

When Austin Wing accompanied the first governor of the Territory of Michigan, Lewis Cass, on an exploration of lands north and northwest of Detroit, they rested for a while on the shores of a spring-fed lake. Grateful for his friend's companionship on an exhausting trip, Cass named it Wing Lake. (1)

The Hager's Abstract of Title records that, a few years later on Sept. 21, 1821, the United States government conveyed to Austin Eli Wing the northeast quarter and southeast quarter of section 29, Town 2 north, Range 10 east, consisting of 320 acres. (2)

Unfortunately, there are no township records to confirm that Wing and his wife, Harriet, built a house on this property, but there are facts and dates that strongly suggest that they did. For instance, it is recorded in the 1818-1837 Biographies of Pioneers that the Wings resided on Bates Street, Detroit, for ten years, moving into their house the latter part of 1814. And, entered in the Burton Historical Collection, Detroit Public Library, is the information that Austin and his family moved to Monroe, Michigan in 1829, where his uncle, the Honorable Warner King, lived and practiced law. But, where did the Wing family live between the years of 1824 and 1829 if not in a house

they built * near a lake named after him, on property he owned - located not too far way from areas where he was engaged in the pursuit of his affairs? Consider the following:

According to the History of Oakland County, Michigan, 1877, Wing was a member of the Pontiac Company, formed Nov. 5, 1818, to found and develop Pontiac, the county seat of Oakland County.

On Sept. 26, 1820, the Detroit Gazette informed its readers of Wing's election as Sheriff of Oakland County.

In 1826, Wing, Governor Cass, and Charles Larned laid out the original plat of the village of Rochester. (3)

The following year, Wing was active in the organization of the Grand Lodge of Michigan (Free Masonry) (4), and the Historical Society of Michigan, June 23, 1828. (5)

On Oct. 1, 1829, the United States, assignee of Austin E. Wing, granted the southeast quarter of section 29, 160 acres, to Elijah Bull (6) who built the large farmhouse still standing at 6115 Wing Lake Road.

Austin and Harriet sold the remainder of the original United States grant, Sept. 14, 1832, to Lewis Cass. (northeast quarter of section 29, 160 acres) (7) (8)

During the less than three years that he owned the property, Cass was a member of President Jackson's cabinet, holding the position of Secretary of War, Aug. 1, 1831-Oct. 5, 1836. It would be highly unlikely that he would have built the Wing Lake house at a time when his duties in Washington were so time-consuming, and when - according to the Biography of Lewis Cass by Willis F. Dunbar - he was already maintaining a residence in Detroit for his wife, Elizabeth, and children.

It would be more reasonable to assume that the Cass family spent Summer months at Wing Lake and that, during one of these stays, Cass had the house recorded - - a first recording only because township recordings at the time Wing built the house were not required. Indeed, Bloomfield Township wasn't created until June 28, 1820 (9), and township recordings, prior to 1832, are rare.

The custom of passing along the history of houses by word-of-mouth was common during the early settlement of Bloomfield Township. Regarding the house at 5841 Wing Lake, its "story" probably began with Wing's close friend, Lewis Cass, at the time he sold the property to the Hunters in 1835. (10) (11)

Over a hundred years later, when Thomas and Esther Carey sold the

* Wings' children probably attended a log-cabin school, one-half mile south of their home. According to the Birmingham Eccentric's Commemorative Centennial Edition, May 14, 1964, the school was erected on the grounds of Jacob Sly's farm in 1824. However, Charles Sly was the only Sly who owned property in this area at the time. (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32) (12)

house to Alton C. Macey and wife, Janet May, in 1950 (12)(13), they verbally passed along its history to the Maceys, exactly as it had been told to them in 1924 by Russell and Leah Baldwin. (14)(15) In turn, faithfully following an old, established tradition, the Maceys related the tale to Laura and Henry Hager

Shortly after receiving his land grant in 1821, General Austin Eli Wing* - pioneer, lawyer, and woodsman - cleared a small area of his land near the northeastern shore of Wing Lake and built a house, and a fortress-like barn of native stone and heavy timbers, with small apertures for the convenience of firearms. Like most settlers, Wing was adept with guns, used for the purpose of hunting, and for protection during skirmishes with inebriated or hostile Indians. (The barn was torn down less than ten years ago, but many Wing Lakers can attest to the fact that its outer walls were pock-marked by ball and shot.)

At that time, Bloomfield Township was a vast forest criss-crossed by Indian Trails. Wild animals thrived in the area: wolf, wildcat, fox, bear, etc.,. Hunters trapped for the skins of beaver, sable, minx, and muskrat. Many kinds of fish and game birds inhabited its innumerable lakes and streams - attracting Ottawas, Chippewas, Hurons, Wyandots, Pottawatomies, Ojibwas, Sacs, and Fox who often made camp on their shores. (16)

Even after peace treaties had been made between the Indian tribes and the Territory of Michigan, it was inevitable that occasional clashes would erupt between settlers (encroaching on lands that had been the Indian's domain for centuries) and the Indians who were slowly being driven away. As the story is told, the General was involved in more than one of them.

The fish-producing lakes of Bloomfield Township were favorite resorts of the Indians. After his repulse at the siege of Detroit, the Ottawa chief, Pontiac, had a lodge on Apple Island in Orchard Lake. The banks of this lake still have sacred burial grounds belonging to the Sacs, Ottawas, Hurons, and Wyandots. (17) This is also true of Wing Lake.

Alton Macey told the Hagers that, while he was excavating the basement to improve the original foundation of the house, he had uncovered numerous Indian artifacts, skeletons, and skulls. His findings were verified to be the remnants of an ancient Indian burial ground.

Research into old army records has yet to be done in order to establish beyond doubt that Austin Wing was ever a general in the United States Army.

1836 - 1850

Lewis Cass sold the northeast quarter of section 29 (160 acres) to John and Margaret Hunter on June 28, 1835. (1) Eight months later, the Hunters sold it to Hamilton Kyle. (2)

Hamilton and Ellen Kyle had five children: Robert, William, Sarah, Jane, and Mary Ellen who became the second wife of Deacon Elijah Bull. (Bull built the large farmhouse at 6115 Wing Lake)

Like most residents of Bloomfield Township, Kyle farmed his land, raising livestock, and planting corn, potatoes, grain, etc., which were bartered for items the family needed, or sold to markets in Franklin and Birmingham.

The Kyle family was active in neighbor-socials, and often travelled on foot, horseback, or horse drawn wagon to Franklin, a small village just two miles away, to buy "necessaries", post a letter at the post office (established in 1828), and to attend church meetings in a little log school house. (3)

In the year of 1840, the first Methodist Protestant Church in Michigan was organized in Franklin. Until a house of worship could be built, church trustees formed the "Franklin Circuit" covering not only Southfield and Bloomfield Counties but Farmers Creek, Lapeer County as well. (4)

When Hamilton Kyle died sometime in the early part of 1844, his executors, Elijah Bull and Robert Kyle, carried out the terms set in his last will and testament. (5)

On January 30, 1851, Sarah Kyle married Solomon Whitney whose father, A.G. Whitney, was the original land owner of the northwest quarter, section 29 (NW side of Wing Lake). (6)(7)

Land on German Mill Road, Franklin, was deeded by Hamilton Kyle's son, William, and his wife, Emily, July 14, 1859, to the trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church of Franklin, one of whom was James Van Every. (8)

The church was built in 1860, but was not formally dedicated to the service of the Almighty God until June 1863. (9) (10)

.....

1849 - 1912

James Van Every married Caroline Durkee on October 30, 1841 (1), and on August 4, 1849, he and Stephen F. Durkee purchased the northeast quarter of section 29 from Robert and Margaret Kyle. (2) Nine months later, Stephen and Nancy Durkee deeded their interest in the property to James Van Every. (3)

James was born on a farm in Hamtramick, Wayne County, on September 18, 1822. His parents, Peter and Amy Van Every, traded their farm for a tract of about 1500 acres near Franklin in 1837, and built a mill (now the Franklin Cider Mill), a distillery, and a potash works in Bloomfield Township. They also farmed their land, and managed a mercantile business in Franklin. (4) They built a large frame house on the northeast corner of Franklin Village in 1835. (known as the Curiosity Shop today) (5)

For a number of years Peter Van Every was a member of the Michigan Territorial Legislature from Wayne County and, at the time that Michigan was admitted to the Union in 1837, was a member of its legislature. (6)

His son, James, wife, Caroline, and children, lived in the house at 5841 Wing Lake for fifty-six years. According to the Portrait Biographical Album of Oakland County, Michigan, 1891, he was a prosperous and representative farmer of Bloomfield Township with a good residence and several excellent barns. His produce consisted of the usual farm crops, meat, dairy products and, some years after he planted his apple orchard, several varieties of apples.

A Democrat in his political principles, James Van Every served as Township Treasurer, and Justice of the Peace. (7)

When James was eighty-three years old, he and his second wife, Matilda, sold their home and acreage to son, James Van Every, Jr., and wife, Lillian. (Nov. 14, 1905) (8)

James, Jr., and his family occupied the house, and farmed the acreage* for seven years before selling the property to Russell and Leah Baldwin on December 17, 1912. (9)

The Henry Hagers (present owners) had the good fortune of meeting James' daughter who was in her eighties at the time (1970). She was born in the house on Wing Lake Road, and her first memory was on Christmas Eve when her grandfather, James Van Every, Sr., gifted her with a small lamb. She was especially pleased to see that some of the favorite trees of her childhood were still flourishing in the yard: the old

As the Hagers so aptly phrased it, "These almost-two acres are steeped in history. It's one of the reasons we treasure it."

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6115 Wing Lake Road (lots 35, 36)1829 - 1871

On October 1, 1829, the United States granted land consisting of 160 acres, southeast quarter of section 29, to Elijah Bull, assignee of Austin Eli Wing. (1)

The long and difficult journey from northern New York state (2) did not dampen Bull's desire to preach the word of the Lord. Even as he was building a small, log cabin on the southeastern shore of Wing Lake (3), clearing and planting his land, the "Deacon" found time to preach whenever he was called upon.

He also served as an Highway Overseer of Road Districts for the Township of Bloomfield in 1831, and assisted Reverend Hornell in organizing the first Presbyterian Church in a log cabin on the Charles Sly farm, June 1, 1831. (northwest quarter of section 32) (4)

No doubt they felt a pressing need for organized worship for the area between the villages of Piety Hill (Birmingham) and Franklin was dotted with taverns that served as meeting places where men could relax and wet their thirst while exchanging news about their livelihood, families, and current politics. Apart from those in Piety Hill, there were Wilkes Durkee's Farm Tavern (corner of Telegraph and Maple), (5) Jacob Sly's Farm Tavern on the site of the present Wing Lake School, Dan Grinnell's place at Stringer's Corner (Franklin and Maple), and Dorus Morton's tavern in Franklin. (6)

Apart from his religious duties, Deacon Elijah Bull continued serving as an Overseer of Road Districts for years 1832 through 1835, and in 1834, he was also a school commissioner. (7)

It is recorded in the Bloomfield Township's Assessor's Field Sheet that the Deacon built "Old Oak", a twelve room farm house of native wood and stone to shelter his wife, Melinda, and later his ten children, in 1833. (8) (This house is still standing at 6115 Wing Lake, and is presently owned by Gerald and Marilyn Tuchow.)

Deacon Bull was appointed School Inspector in 1836 and, in 1839, held the office of Commissioner of Highways. (9)

The Abstracts of Title for the Hager and Tuchow properties on Wing Lake Road establish that sometime between July 1832 and March 1844, Melinda Bull died, and the Deacon then married Mary Ellen, daughter of his neighbor, Hamilton Kyle.

In 1848, Elijah Bull was elected agent of the church and congregation with complete power to transact any and all business pertaining to the erection of a house of worship. One of the contributors to the building fund was Peter Van Every who offered a barrel of whiskey as his donation. The donation was accepted and sold - the money used to buy shingles for the church. (10)

The Presbyterian Church occupied its first church building in the same year of 1848. It was built on land just south of Maple, on the west side of Franklin Road. (11)

Not only was the Deacon a firm Presbyterian and the main supporter of that form of worship, but he was an excellent farmer as well. His farm was one of the best in Bloomfield Township. (12)

On May 4, 1856, Elijah and Mary Ellen Bull donated part of the east half of the southwest quarter of section 29, containing 76/100 acres of land, to the District Board of School, District No. 6, of Bloomfield Township. (13) (The little stone school, built in 1857, still stands on the corner of Wing Lake and Maple Roads. Today, it is known as the Wing Lake School Historical Centre.)

Deacon Bull held the position of clerk in the Presbyterian Church from 1831 to 1870. Later, when the church was discontinued (some historians say it was destroyed by fire), many of its members transferred to the Methodist Protestant Church in Franklin. (14)

Deacon Elijah Bull died on August 9, 1871, leaving the following heirs: Mary E. Bull, widow; William and Moses, sons; Julia, Cornelia, Arietta, Ellen, Catharine, Jennie, Caroline Shaffer, and Mary E. West, daughters. (15)

1874 - 1879

William Bull, as executor of his father's will, sold the property, then consisting of 240 acres more or less, to William P. Durkee on October 15, 1874. (1)

Durkee, a farmer and building contractor, also carried out duties of a Bloomfield Township Overseer of Highways in 1833; Supervisor of Road Districts, 1837, 1838, and 1840. In 1841, he was appointed Assessor and, again, Overseer of Highways in 1846 and 1847. (2)

On February 18, 1860, a building contract was entered into between William Durkee and the trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church in Franklin to build their first church building on land deeded to trustees by Hamilton Kyle's son, William, and his wife, Emily, on July 14, 1859. (3)

William P. Durkee died on March 24, 1879, and his will was filed for probate five days later.

1894 - 1926

Jefferson and Mary Thurber bought 120 acres (east half of southwest quarter, and west half of southeast quarter of section 29) on April 2, 1894. (1)

He farmed his land, raising livestock, farm crops, etc., and harvesting apples from the orchard that William P. Durkee had planted.*

Thurber's wife, Mary, died on April 10, 1920 (2). Five years later, Jefferson (still a widower) entered into a contract with the Wing Lake Land Company to plat his land (lots 1 to 243) for a subdivision to be called Wing Lake Shores. (3) and, on March 28, 1928, Thurber's property (with the exception of his house on lots 35 and 36) was conveyed to the Wing Lake Land Company. (4)

Jefferson Thurber sold his home to Warner & Moore, a Michigan corporation of Detroit, on January 30, 1926. (5)

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* I interviewed James Richard Tollman (28081 W. 12 Mile Road, Farmington Hills, Michigan) on August 26, 1975. He was eighty-four years old at the time, and has lived in this area all his life. He well remembers doing chores for Jefferson Thurber, and stated that the apple trees in his orchard were at least thirty or forty years old then. Many of these trees are still bearing fruit today.
