the co-op program offers actual work experience. cooperating offices are selected to provide the opportunities for a supervised educational experience to prepare the co-op for his or her intended career objective.



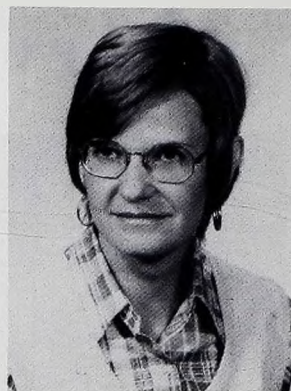

in social studies, the problems of the world are studied, and students leave better equipped to handle them.

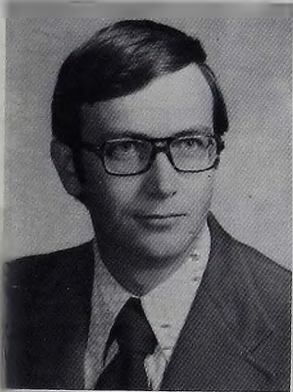
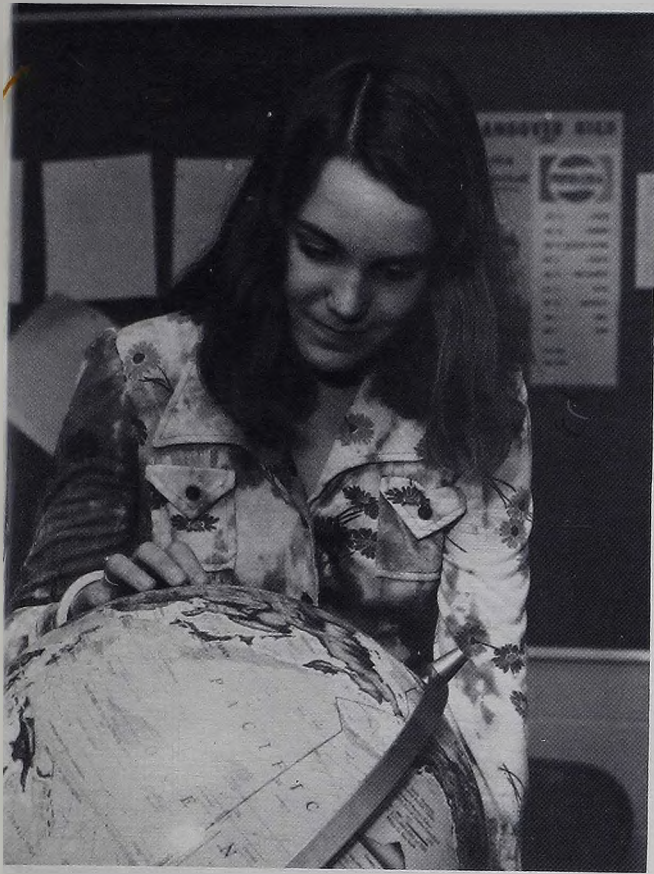

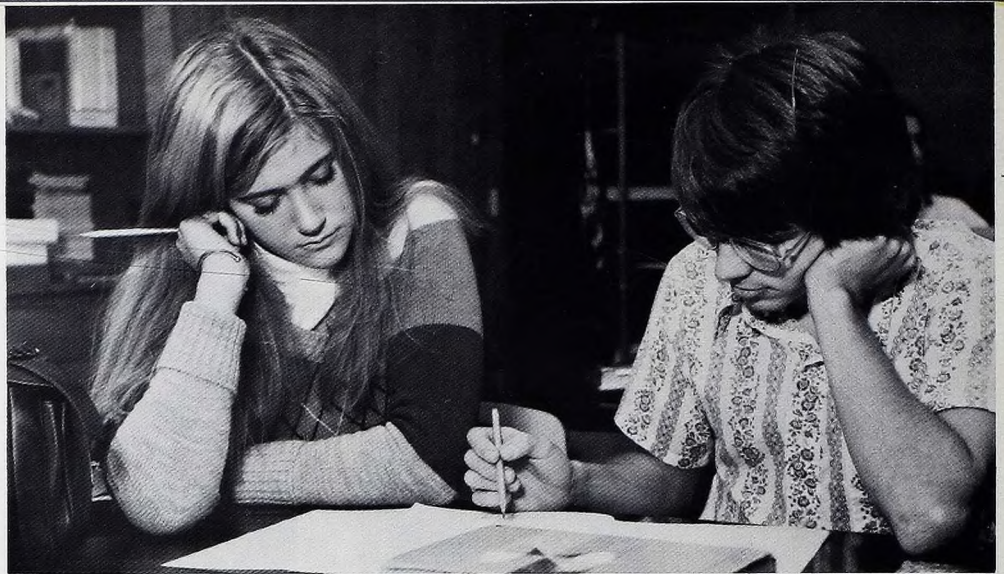
swimming, taught by miss powell and mr. lane, who is the winner of several distinguished swimming awards, offers water safety to the students which will always be useful in future life.

the science department promotes an awareness of the importance that ecology plays in preparing the student for the future and, therefore, stresses our environmental approach.

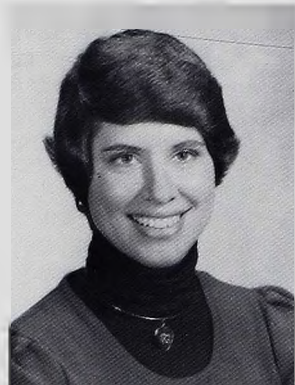

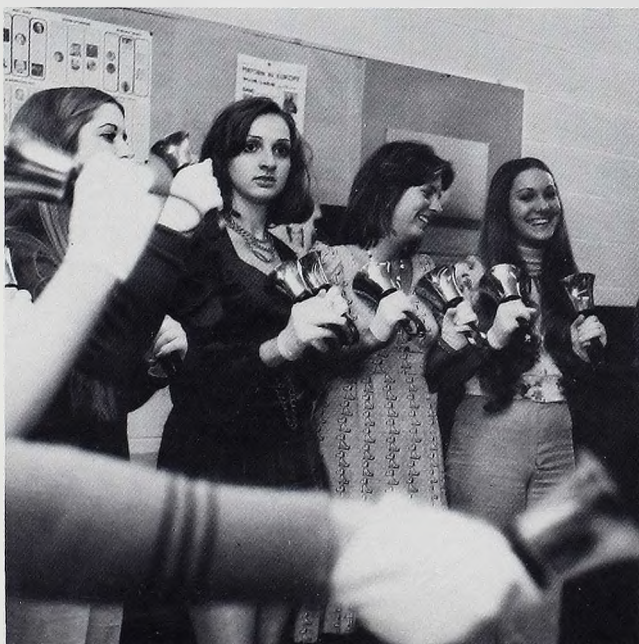

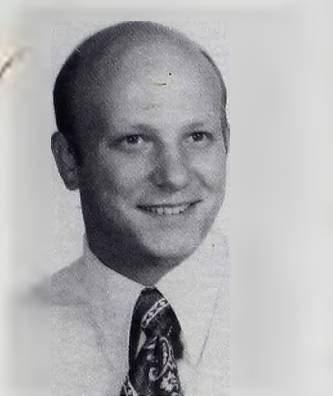
the andover music department, under the direction of mr. craig strain and mrs. carolyn eynon, offers to students a wide variety of ensembles and classes.

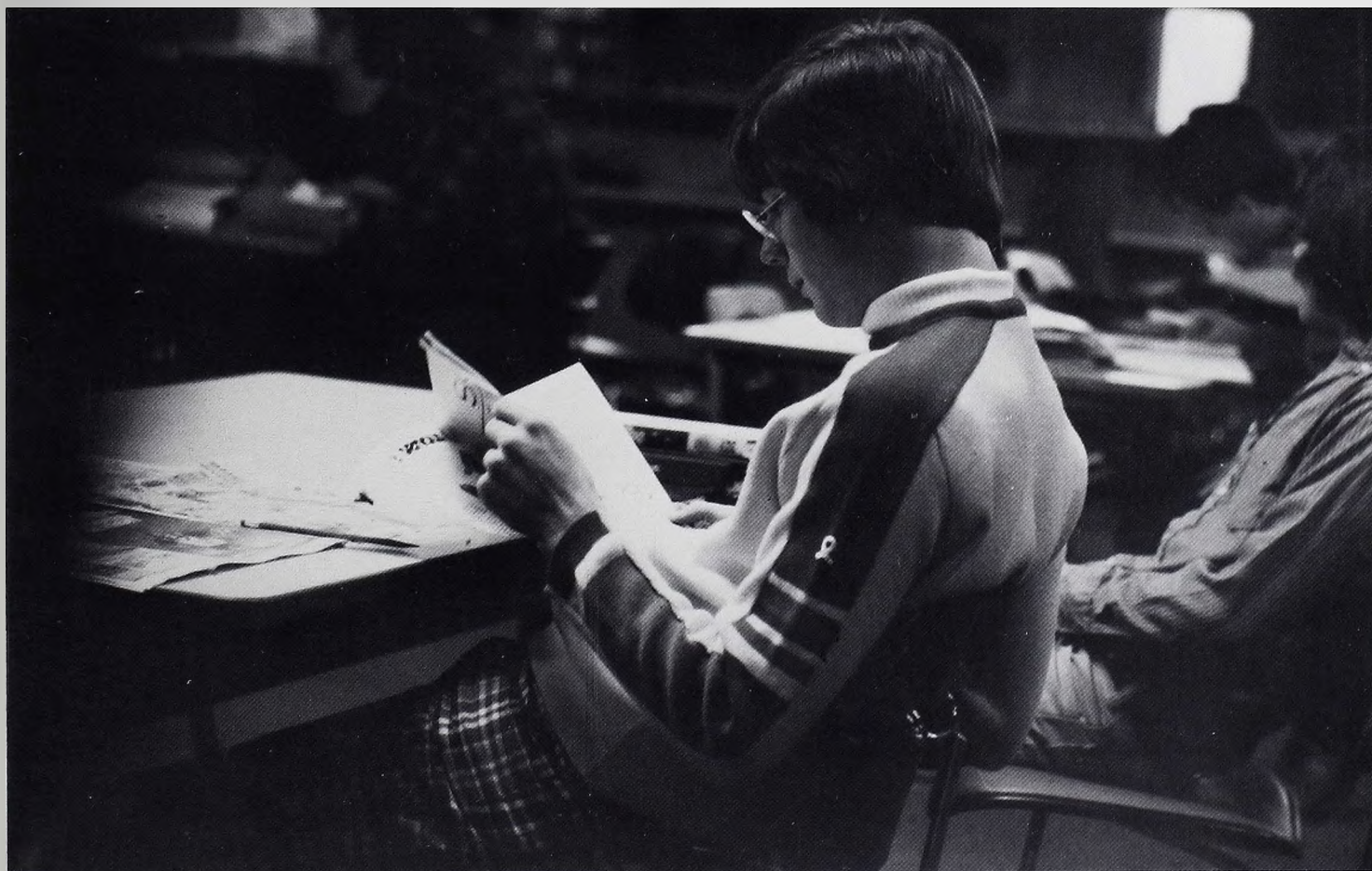
without question, the media center is a vital part of andover. students use it to gain valuable information for reports, or to find a good book.
